DEPARTMENT 11 EXOTIC ANIMALS ATCP 160.19

Regulations:

1. All goats exhibited here must have a scrapie premise identification tag or tattoo. They must also have a health certificate issued no more than 30 days in advance of show. This certificate must be issued by an accredited veterinarian. No animals will be permitted to unload without the tag certificate and checked in by superintendent.
2. Animals eligible to show in any other department will not be allowed to exhibit here.
3. Exhibitors may not enter more than one animal in each item number.
4. Entrants must be a member of a recognized youth group of Jackson County.

Regulations:

1. A naturally polled pygmy is disqualified from the show.
2. Any pygmy with warts, abscesses, mange, ringworm, or any other contagious disease is prohibited from showing. Any animal found to be infected will be immediately removed from the premises.

REGULATIONS:

BEST FIBERED ANGORA GOAT

DEPARTMENT 13 -CATS ATCP NO. 160.615

Regulations:

1. No adult, whole males to be shown.
2. Mixed breed and purebred cats will show together.
3. Members will be required to bring their own animals to the judging table.
4. Judging will include general appearance and condition.
5. *Cats need to be present one-half hour prior to judging time to be checked in.*
6. **All cats are required to have a rabies and distemper inoculation and exhibitors will be required to furnish vaccination certificates before cats are checked in on judging day.**
7. All cats will be inspected proper to check-in. Any cat showing signs of illness or infection will be sent home.
8. A kitten must be 4 months old and be vaccinated for 15 days prior to the fair.
9. For judges safety — claw tips should be clipped.
10. Cats should be taken home right after judging or as soon as possible. They will not stay overnight.
11. All cats must be on a leash when being shown.

Definitions: Long hair - hair coat more than one inch in length
Short hair - hair coat one inch or less in length
