DEFINITION: Cockerels and pullets are birds hatched on or after January 1 of exhibit year. Chickens over 4 months of age will be pullorum tested. They need to be tested before the opening day of the fair. Rene Rommel is a licensed pullorium tester. His phone number is (608) 488-4753.

REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitor must be present when poultry is judged.
2. Animals will be brought to the fair, in humane cages.
3. Meat Market animals will be weighed at check in time with exhibitor or parent present. Birds not making weight will be disqualified and sent home.
4. No premium will be paid on disqualified birds or birds lacking merit.
5. No exhibitor is allowed more than 1 entry in an item number.
6. Pen rental is 25¢ per bird.
7. Feed will be provided but exhibitors are responsible for feeding, watering, and cleaning their own pens every day. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
8. All birds will be inspected by superintendent upon check in. Birds shall be checked in by 10:30 on entry day. Unhealthy birds will be sent home.
9. Showmanship will be judged last.
10. Exhibits will be grouped by clubs and award given for decorations, good care and cleanliness.

BEST OF SHOW RIBBON

REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibitor must be present when rabbits are judged.
2. Exhibitor may not show more than three breeds, one entry per lot.
3. Animals must be brought to the fair in humane, well-ventilated cages.
4. All rabbits must be in place by 10:30 a.m. on entry day.
5. The Department Superintendent will inspect animals as they are entered. Any animal showing signs of illness or infection will be sent home.
6. Only rabbits being exhibited will be allowed in the building.
7. Each exhibitor must clean, feed and water their animals daily, keeping barn clean.
8. Pen rental 25¢ per rabbit.
9. Exhibits will be grouped by club or group.
10. Fryer Pen rabbits will be weighed on entry with exhibitor present.
11. Showmanship Classes will be held at the end of judging.
12. Cavies will be brought the day of judging & taken home afterwards.
