UW-Extension's staff will provide you with horticulture training so that you will be able to help others. Within twelve months of course completion each participant is requested to complete 24 hours of community service.

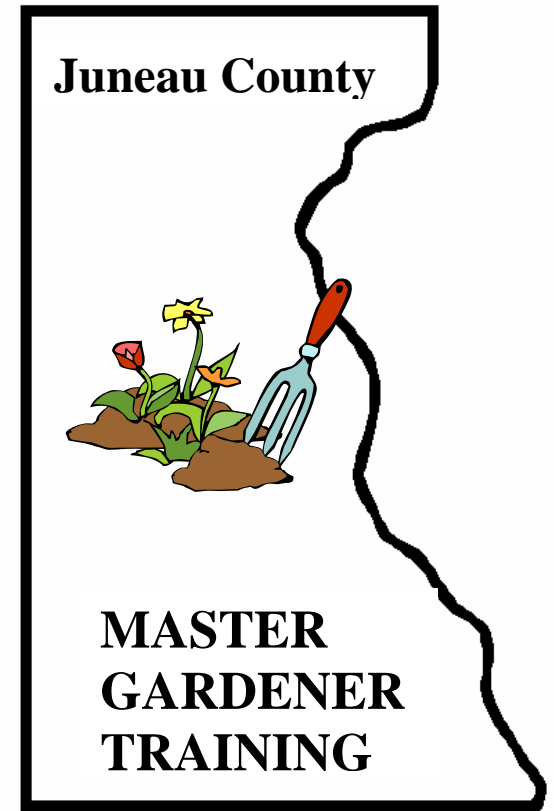
Past participants have fulfilled their community service time by:
