DRAMA

- Original or Interpretive
- By yourself or as a group
- Can use props
- Humorous or Dramatic
- Judged on acting and presentation

MUSIC

- Must bring own instrument and stand
- Individual or group
- May use multiple pieces to reach required time limit

DANCE

- Tap
- Ballet
- Jazz
- Ballroom
- Other

The Kenosha County 4-H Council, Inc., at their January 26, 2009, meeting voted to change the operating structure of how the Public Presentation Festival is coordinated. One of the major changes separates this event from the Kenosha County Fair. In the past, Kenosha County 4-H members who participated in the Public Presentation Festival could also count it as a Kenosha County Fair entry and receive a ribbon and a premium award from the Kenosha County Fair. Under the new structure, 4-H members may not count their participation as a Kenosha County Fair entry. If a 4-H member would like to have their Public Presentation Festival project work displayed at the Kenosha County Fair, members must complete a Fair Entry form (refer to Department 18 Class B, C, or D for options) and have their work judged at the Kenosha County Fair.
