The following dates listed below are the GYMKHANA Clinics to be held for youth and their project horse/pony to attend and to meet requirements to show at our fair in 2008.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- Registration Application is due by May 10th or before.
- All riders/horses are to be in proper riding attire (boots, pants, helmet, shirt, etc.) and equipment.
- Clinics are held rain or shine
- Must have original **and** copy of Coggins test with them at check-in.
- NO YOUTH & HORSE ARE TO BE LEFT TO ATTEND CLINIC WITHOUT PARENT OR GUARDIAN (OVER AGE 18). SOMEONE MUST BE PRESENT ON FAIR GROUNDS

ATTENTION: CHANGES FOR 2008 GYMKHANA CLINICS

- Each participant will need to choose ONE DATE to do your clinic.
- Actual clinic time will be 45 minutes with a 15 minute warm-up in arena (1 hour total)
- Each date will be broken into 2 groups
 1st group Warm-up at 5:45pm Clinic starts at 6:00pm SHARP!
 2nd group Warm-up at 6:45pm Clinic starts at 7:00pm
- You will be notified by Angie as to what time you clinic is at. (If you are the 2nd group you are welcome to come early and watch)
- By having 2 groups I'm hoping to get groups smaller and separated into experience levels.
- Please have your registration in early so I have time to get you in a clinic date and time.

A \$10 Registration Fee *must* be sent with application (made out to La Crosse County 4-H Horse). This Fee will be returned at the time you sign in for the clinic with all papers needed.
