2. School focused training (DPI) w/ teams of schools (including youth and adults). **DONE in Feb 2007 @ First Banking Center, with good attendance. F/U – Will offer the SOS curriculum to all Lafayette County schools. (*Motion by Debbie, 2nd by Jesse to move forward with using grant \$\$ to purchase the HS version of SOS for each interested school- approx \$300 each- including all Lafayette County schools and Mineral Point + Cuba City, motion passed) Tom will also bring this up at the next student pupil services meeting. Tom also mentioned he would f/u with a letter to administrators.**
3. Community wide training – QPR may be good for this sort of open community forum.
