

Little Britches Dairy Showmanship Event

-Sponsored by FFA Alumni -

Purpose:

To help youth gain experience in showing a dairy calf at the county fair. The event may help youth decide to join 4-H and take the dairy project when the youth enters 3rd grade or older as of January 1.

Rules:

1. Open to 4-H and non 4-H members 5-7 years old as of January 1 who do not have dairy cattle entered in the fair.
2. Youth should show a dairy calf in a showmanship event at the Langlade County Youth Fair.
3. Youth should show a calf (Spring Only) of a 4-H or FFA member who has entered the Dairy Calf Fair Class at the fair. If more calves are needed the committee will get them.
4. The youth would need to work with the 4-H or FFA member in cleaning and leading the calf before the show.
5. The number of classes would be decided by the number of youth by their age group.
6. Youth shall fill out entry form (available at Extension Office) and return the form to Becky Gleich by July 20, 2009. Becky's address is N6109 Highway 45, Deerbrook, WI 54424.
7. Each youth would receive a fair ribbon (blue). The groups would not be ranked.
