**Directions:** The dairy farm is located on the corners of Shady Lane Road and County I between Hwys A and Hwy 33 in Ozaukee County.

**From the north,** travel Hwy 57 to Hwy A at Fredonia. Travel west on Hwy A through Fredonia to Hwy I. Travel south on Hwy I approximately 3 miles to Shady Lane Road. Turn west on Shady Lane Road.

**From the south,** travel Hwy 33 between Saukville and Newburg to Hwy I. Travel north on Hwy I approximately 3 miles to Shady Lane Road. Turn west on Shady Lane Road.

This training session provided both in English & Spanish will provide basic information and hands on training on calf care taught jointly by UW-Extension Sheboygan County Dairy Agent Tina Kohlman and Julia Reyes Hamann, independent dairy consultant and former calf manager for a 700-cow dairy.

- \* Tail Docking

Both English and Spanish speaking dairy workers are encouraged to attend. **The session is limited to 20 individuals** to give participants an opportunity to participate in the demonstrations and hands on activities, **so pre-registration is required.** Each participant will receive materials and handouts in his/her appropriate language and a certificate indicating he/she completed the "Dairy Workers' Training-Calf Management Skills".
