

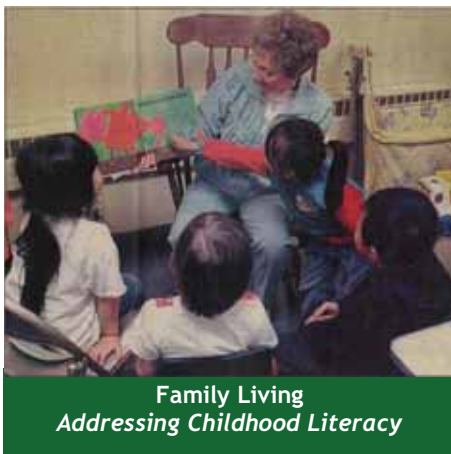


Big Things Can and Do Happen with a Small Budget!

Although the Manitowoc County UW-Extension Department accounts for just 0.4% of the annual county budget, county residents receive a lot for their money.

Fact: UW-Extension Educator salaries are 40% county funded and 60% state funded resulting in nearly \$138,000 of state tax dollars coming to Manitowoc County annually.

Fact: Every year UW-Extension education programs touch the lives of approximately 16,000 county residents. That's 1 in 5 county residents!

- **Educating and Empowering Citizen Volunteers**



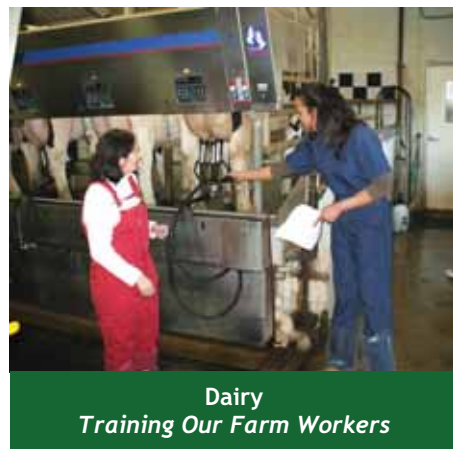
Fact: UW-Extension volunteers annually donate over 27,000 hours to county residents, and the dollar value of their service is a whopping \$440,000!

Fact: For every \$1.00 that Manitowoc County invests in UW-Extension, county residents receive an estimated \$5.44 in educational services.
