SHARE (Self-Help and Resource Exchange)

- ★ Distributes a monthly food package worth about approximately \$30-35 in exchange for two hours volunteer service and \$15-20 in cash, plus a small fee for transportation. The specific contents vary each month based on the season.
- ★ Distribution is once a month. Advance registration required.
- ★ No income guidelines.
