Insect identification, fruit tree problems, and plant disease questions are answered by the Horticulture Agent and Master Gardeners.

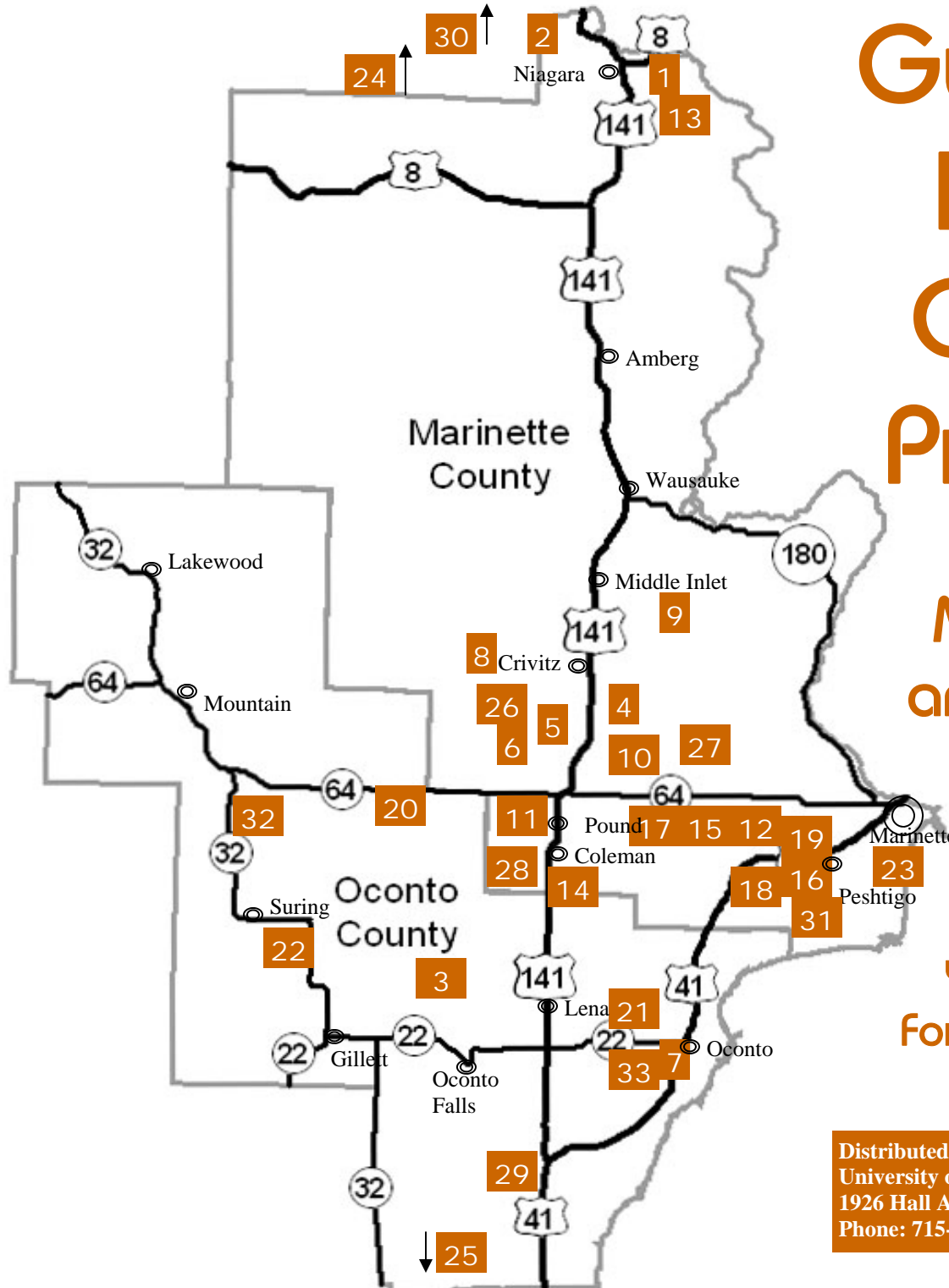
