## Department 10 – Caged Birds and Small Pets

### Requirements:

1. Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4-H Caged Birds and Small Pets project or other youth groups carrying a similar program as their supervised project. Specify species on entry form. (Ex. Small Mammals--mouse or gerbil; Reptile--turtle)
2. Any animal displaying symptoms of a contagious disease or parasites will not be allowed to show.
3. All pets should be brought to the fair in a suitable cage or container for judging.

4. Tropical fish should not be brought to the fair. Exhibitors should turn in a scrapbook containing a description of the project and photos. Each successive year the exhibitors will update and add to the existing scrapbook. Scrapbooks may be 8 ½ x 11 or 12 x 12 inches in size.
5. The Caged Bird and Other Small Pet show will take place the Sunday before the main Fair dates beginning at 8:30 a.m. Caged birds and small pets will be brought in at the time of judging and taken home that same day.
6. An overall best of show will be selected from all entries in these classes.
