PULLORUM TESTER SEMINARS

The Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, Division of Animal Health, will be offering ten pullorum tester training seminars in April 2009. Attendance at one of these seminars is mandatory for those who would like to renew their Pullorum certification or those that would like to become a Pullorum tester for the first time. All current certifications for Pullorum testers will expire on June 30, 2009. The cost to become a certified Pullorum tester is \$25.00. This fee will not be collected at the training seminar, but must be mailed to the Division of Animal Health with the certification training form received at the training seminar. Pre-registration is not required to attend these seminars. Certified testers must be at least 18 years of age.

Current pullorum testers will not be required to perform an agglutination test, but those certifying for the first time will be trained to accurately perform an agglutination test. Participants must arrive by the starting time of the seminar. The seminar schedule follows.
