WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning Law, section 66.1001 (4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, requires the Governing body of a local government unit to "adopt written procedures that are designed to foster Public participation, including open discussion, communication programs, information services and Public meetings for which advance notice has been provided, in every stage of the comprehensive plan",  
And

WHEREAS, section 66 1001(4)(a) further requires that "The written procedures shall provide for wide Distribution of proposed, alternative or amended elements of a comprehensive plan and shall provide an Opportunity for written comments of the plan to be submitted by members of the public to the governing Body and for the governing body to respond to such written comments",

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town Board of the Town of Alban , Portage County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the Board on this day, the third of June, 2003, hereby Adopts the public participation guidelines entitled Portage County Comprehensive Plan. Public Participation Plan, dated July 25, 2001, attached hereto, to take effect the day after posting, and directs The Town Clerk to publish this resolution as a Class 1 notice under chapter 985, Wisconsin Statutes, and Post this resolution and guidelines in (three) public places, in accordance with section 60 80, Wisconsin Statutes, and to make such guidelines available for public inspection.
