We will highlight some of our favorite activities from the Wisconsin 4-H Community Club Central website that you can use at your club meetings to teach your club members and officers how to make meetings more fun and productive! Presenters: Wisconsin 4-H Youth Leader Council Members

Blast Off With 4-H S.E.T. - Science, engineering and technology are all around us. Come and find out how youth leaders can use science and engineering in a fun, hands on way in any 4-H project, from Mechanical Science to Foods and Nutrition! You will practice some simple science activities and write up an activity of your own. Come and learn how you can be a leader with 4-H SET! Presenters: Deb Ivey and Jessie Potterton

Camp Counselor 101 - Get an in-depth view of what it's like to be a camp counselor and a way you can contribute to your county camping program to make the experience even more successful.
