

Rock County 4-H Horse & Pony Project
HORSE BUCKS AWARD PROGRAM

The Horse Bucks Award Program is available to all 4-H Horse, Horseless & Pony Project members. Members receive one horse buck for each point earned. Horse bucks are the only form of currency recognized at the Horse Bucks Auction. Horse Bucks do not carry over from one project year to the next. Items for the auction are donated by businesses & project member families that participate in the Horse Buck Program.

Points are collected starting at the February meeting. Points are collected on Horse Bucks forms for all activities. **Project members are responsible for reporting all your own horse bucks on the form included in this packet.** Project members must be present to do their own bidding at the Horse Bucks Auction. Forms may be turned in or mailed to a Horse Bucks Committee member. **All forms must be in by December 15.** **Points are allowed as follows:**

DIVISION I Five (5) Points

- A. Attend horse camp (per day).
- B. Work project year with horseless horse member.
- C. Participate in county 4-H public speaking or demonstration contest on horse topic at Communication Arts Festival. Write article for publication (magazine, newsletter, etc.)
- D. Volunteer to work at booth at Midwest Horse Fair (per day).
- E. Horseless Horse member who fulfills contract with horse partner.

DIVISION II Three (3) Points

- F. Belong to saddle club or breed organization.
- G. Take your horse for a live animal demonstration.
- H. For each parade you ride in.
- I. For each day of an Equine Youth Board meeting, organized trail ride, open or breed horse show, competitive ride or gymkhana event you participate in.
- J. Participate in the following at other horse events, contests and /or State Expo: Horse Bowl, Judging, Hippology, Photography, Poster, Drawing, Speaking, Demonstration and/or Model Horse.
- K. Each day you volunteer work at a riding facility for the physically challenged (such as SMILES).

DIVISION III Two (2) Points

- L. For each day you attend Midwest Horse Fair.
- M. Placing in the following at other horse events, contests and/or State Expo: Horse Bowl, Judging, Hippology, Photography, Poster, Drawing, Speaking, Demonstrations and/or Model Horse.
- N. Spectator only at horse events, clinics, open or breed shows.
- O. Give a speech or demonstration about horses at county project meetings, local 4-H club meeting or at school.
- P. Work at horse related event; handing out ribbons, hat chaser, etc.

DIVISION IV One (1) Point

- Q. For each Horse Bowl, Hippology, Judging, Model Horse or other educational meeting you attend.
- R. Horse selected for the State 4-H Horse Expo.

DIVISION V Graded One (1) to Five (5) Points

- S. Junior Leader in Horse Project (List what you have done).
- T. One full page written by member on what member has learned from 4-H during this project year.

DIVISION VI TEN (10) POINTS

- U. Set-up of arena or clean-up of fairgrounds before/after May, June and/or July shows (each time).

TEN (10) POINTS:

Set-up of arena or clean-up of fairgrounds before/after May, June and/or July shows (each time).
Set-up and/or take down of pony stalls before/after June horse camp and/or fair show (each time).

FIVE (5) Points for attendance at:

January	Informational meeting
February	Model Horse Clinic
March	Extravaganza-Photography, Poster, Model Horse, etc. Open Arenas
April	Horse Bowl, Hippology & Judging Clinic Open Arenas
May	Participation Clinic & Mini Show
June	Rock Co.4-H Open Horse Show Pony Fun Day Horseless Horse Meeting

THREE (3) Participation Points per Educational Event:

March	Extravaganza – Photography, Poster, Model Horse, etc.
April	Horse Bowl, Hippology & Judging Clinic.

THREE (3) Participation Points for:

May	Participation Clinic and/or Mini-Show
June	Rock Co. 4-H Open Horse Show Pony Fun Day
