A. County-wide meetings:

1. Thursday, February 15 - 7:00 p.m., Courthouse - orientation, get acquainted and organizational meeting

B. Aircraft practice:

- Saturday, June 9 - 10:00 a.m.–noon, Parker High School athletic field, Janesville – Mandatory registration, aircraft trimming, set-up and practice fly (Rain date – Sunday, June 10, same time and location)

C. 4-H Fair Aircraft Fly - aircraft built to fly will be judged on this date:

- Saturday, June 23 – Parker High School athletic field, Janesville. The spot landing glider contest will also be held on this date, using the Guillows F-15 Eagle glider. (**NOTE: this is the CORRECT date!**) (Rain date – Sunday June 24, same time and location)
 - a. 9:30 - 11:00 a.m. - registration, spot landing contest, final trimming and set-up
 - b. 11 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. - aircraft built to fly construction judging and timed fly-off

D. Entry and judging day at the Rock County 4-H Fair is Tuesday, July 24. All aircraft and other aircraft projects are due. Face-to-face judging is 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. in the Blackhawk Building.

E. Exhibit release is Sunday, July 29, 7:00-9:00 p.m. in the Blackhawk Building.
