

Sheboygan County 4-H Alumni Association Scholarship

Due: March 1

Description

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded by the Sheboygan County 4-H Alumni Association.

Eligibility

- a. Applicant must be a 4-H Alumni or currently a member of the Sheboygan 4-H Program.
- b. All high school seniors or post high school students (not over the age of 21 as of January 1) planning on attending a college or technical school for the upcoming school year.
- c. 4-H members are eligible to receive only one scholarship from the 4-H Alumni Association.

Requirements

- a. Three letters of recommendation.
 - One from a 4-H representative (not a parent).
 - Two from any other source.
- b. Applicant must include a 100 word typed essay stating why they are deserving of the scholarship.

Administrative

- a. All scholarship application forms and letters of recommendation must be received in the UW-Extension Office, 5 University Drive, Sheboygan, WI 53081, by March 1.
- b. Final selection and awarding of the scholarship will be made by the Sheboygan County 4-H Alumni Association.
- c. Scholarship recipients will be notified in early April. Award will be presented at the Alumni Banquet in May.
- d. After recipient has been selected, recipients must show proof of acceptance by the school of choice.
- e. Scholarship will be paid directly to the school in the name of the recipient.
