Dressage rides will be limited to 60 per day. Excess entries will be returned based on postmark day.

All First Level Test ride times will be assigned, beginning at 7:30AM, with 6 minute intervals. After the first level tests are complete, the ring will be reset to 20X40 meters. All other tests will be scheduled by the exhibitor at registration. **If you do not show up for your scheduled ride time, you will forfeit your time. You may be able to reschedule for a later time based on availability.**

**\*NEGATIVE COGGINS: ORIGINAL AND COPY NEEDED TO ENTER FAIRGROUNDS**

**\*THIS IS A 4-H SPONSORED EVENT. THEREFORE ALL EXHIBITORS, REGARDLESS OF AGE DIVISION, MUST WEAR AN ASTM/SEI APPROVED HELMET, AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED - NO EXCEPTIONS**

**\*\*STATE 4-H RULE REQUIRES ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE IN AT LEAST 3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE AS OF JAN. 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2009\*\***

\*Entries day of show will close 2 classes prior to class being entered; entries for classes 1-3 will close at 7:50 AM, classes will be held no more than 2 minutes for tack changes.

\*Warm-up over fences will begin at 6:30 AM (in the main ring), and run through the end of class number 3. In addition, we will have a warm-up for cross rails and hunter hack during the lunch break.

**\*Classes 1-3 will be held in the rear portion of the warm-up ring beginning at 8:00 AM.**

\*Maiden Jumping Classes: Class #21-Maiden Equitation, **rider** never to have won any jumping class. Class #22-Maiden Hunter, **horse** never to have won any jumping class.

\*Novice Horse: **Horse** never to have won a first place - in that division.

\*Novice Rider: **Rider** never to have won a first place in any equitation class.

\*Pony riders: 15 & under, pony must be 56" or under.

**\*Limited stalls available:** stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with pre-entry only. Each stall is \$20 per day with \$10 per day refund if stall is cleaned. If staying/paying for the weekend, you will receive a \$20 refund on Sunday, if your stall is cleaned. **\*All horses staying overnight must be registered with the show office. Any horse occupying a stall, that is not registered, will be asked to leave.**
