

Points to Remember


Return the registration form at least 10 days before the class you wish to attend. This will ensure that you will receive the training manuals well in advance of the class.

2008 PESTICIDE CERTIFICATION FOR PRIVATE APPLICATORS

Who Should Attend?

All private applicators who require re-certification or individuals who wish to become certified for the first time.

Certification is required for all private applicators who purchase or use “Restricted Use Pesticides.” Because of the new Worker Protection Standard, employers may want to have employees who handle pesticides also become certified.
