The farm is located at the corners of Hwy U and Hwy E south of Plymouth.
From Hwy 57 south of Plymouth, go west on Hwy U approximately 2 miles to the farm.

This training session provided both in English & Spanish is designed to teach dairy workers about the importance of a good milk quality program along with methods to obtain high quality milk. The session will provide basic information on mastitis detection, mastitis bacteria and how they cause mastitis, and proper milking procedures and the reason behind the basic steps in the routine. The hands-on training will be taught by Pam Ruegg, UW-Extension Milk Quality Outreach Specialist with Julia Reyes Hamann, DATCP Beginning Farmer Program Specialist, translating the meeting.

Topics addressed include:

- * What is considered high quality milk
- * Characteristics of a proper milking routine
- * Importance of fore stripping and milk letdown
- * Importance of udder hygiene
- * Identifying mastitis
- * California Mastitis Test
- * Proper milk collection techniques for cultures

Both English and Spanish speaking dairy workers are encouraged to attend. **The session is limited to 20 individuals** to give participants an opportunity to participate in the demonstrations and hands on activities, **therefore pre-registration is required.**

Each participant will receive a certificate indicating he/she completed the "Dairy Workers' Training-Milking Skills".
