

## **Walworth County Policy for Recognition of Graduating 4-H Members**

For a member to be recognized as a graduating member at the annual Junior/Senior Leaders' Recognition Banquet, he/she must have finished the 4-H year as a member in good standing with his/her club. A 4-H member in good standing is one who has met all of the requirements for active membership at the club level including meeting attendance and record book completion. Members in their final year of 4-H who are in college or other education or training programs outside of Walworth County may be excused, in consultation with club general leaders, from attending regular monthly meetings of their clubs except when home on breaks. General leaders will submit by county deadlines each fall the names of youth from their club who are eligible for recognition as graduating members.
