PRE-REGISTRATION

- Applicators must sign-up for a class and pick up class textbooks at least one week prior to the class/session date.
- Applicators may register and pay at any UW-Extension Office (Racine, Kenosha or Walworth).

Textbooks can be mailed, but only after a check made payable to UW-Extension is received for \$34.60 (\$30.00 fee plus postage). Checks must be received at least two weeks before the training or testing day.
