Wisconsin Acidified Canned Foods Training for Small Food Processors

Overview:

Canning salsa, pickles, and other acidified foods for sale requires special training. The Acidified Canned Foods Training is a one-day workshop designed to teach the basics of food safety and regulation in the manufacture of acidified foods in Wisconsin. Whether you have a business that you wish to expand, or you are just in the planning stages, the Acidified Canned Foods Training will be helpful to you. Participants completing the day-long workshop and scoring a satisfactory grade on exams will receive the training necessary to apply for a Wisconsin acidified foods processors' license. The training is offered on eight different dates and at seven locations across the state.

Training will cover:

- ◆ Wisconsin food processing regulations
- ◆ Facility requirements
- ◆ Food safety and sanitation
- ◆ Principles of thermal processing
- ◆ Microbiology of acidified foods
- ◆ Record keeping and forms
- ◆ Recipe approval

There will be time set aside for learning, group discussion, and hands-on exercises.

Registration begins at 8:30 a.m., and the program will run until 4:00 pm. You must attend for the full day. There will be morning and afternoon discussions and two exams. Lunch will be on your own.
