

## 4-H CLUB TALLY SHEET FOR PARTICIPATION MEDALS






The 4-H Club Tally Sheet is designed to help you report your accomplishments at the close of the year. It lists 27 items, or opportunities, in 4-H. This sheet will be used to determine recipients of the participation/recognition medals (bronze, silver, gold) only.


You must complete the item requirements needed to earn a Bronze Pin, at least 12 points, to earn a Silver Pin, at least 16 points, or to earn a Gold Pin, at least 20 points. For each rank you must complete five of the first seven item requirements. These are of importance in the careers of all successful members. No more than one point may be taken for any number, 1 through 27. The requirements listed for each item are the minimum number, well within the reach of every ambitious 4-H member. Try to build your record by completing many items rather than just the minimum number.

Use numbers at all times in all the spaces on the Tally Sheet, rather than checks or X's.
