“This is your life” Interview

1. **Pair off with a stranger for the next 20 minutes. If you are the spouse/partner of an LWC participant, try to find another spouse/partner to pair off with.**
2. **Interview each other to find out who your partner is and what he or she brings to LWC.** What is his or her nature? What makes your partner go and stop, turn on and off? What talents does this person possess? What value does this person offer? Why did this person want to be in LWC and what are his or her expectations?

3. **Some suggested ice breakers:**

If Ed McMahon delivered a check to you from Publisher's Clearing House for \$10M, how would you spend the money?

If your physician told you that you had only six more months to live, how would you spend your time?

Greatest talents, abilities, and accomplishments?

If you were reborn and lived your life again, what one thing would you change? What would you not change?

Biggest prouds and sorries?

4. **As the interviewer, TAKE NO NOTES.** Just listen well, probe for clarification but not for interrogation. As the interviewee, feel free to share a realistic portrait of yourself.
5. **Provide the group with a 60 second introduction of your partner.** Who is he/she? What value does your partner bring to LWC? What is unique or special about your partner?
