Who Can Join?

Waushara County Horse Association is open to all 4-H club members who are in the Horse, Horseless Horse, Managerial Horse or Exploring project. Members must join a 4-H Club first before joining the Horse Association. For information on joining a 4-H club, please contact the UW-Extension Office at 920-787-0416.

Membership dues are \$7 per family per year. Re-enrolling members sign up by December 1st. New members must sign up by the January meeting.

Meetings are held monthly, usually on the 2nd Monday of each month at the Courthouse Demo Room at 6:30pm.

Members attending 50% of meetings will receive recognition. Each member must participate in fund raising for the club.

- ☆ Horse Association offers a **horse camp** each spring. You get 2 full days of instruction for about half the value (~\$200)!!
- ☆ Horse Association offers monthly “mini clinics” so you can learn about horses all year long.
- ☆ **Summer opportunities** may be held at no additional charge to members. Topics and availability is determined by the Horse Association.
- ☆ In the spring a safety clinic is provided for those planning to attend horse camp.
- ☆ There are many opportunities for **older youth** to share their knowledge with other youth as club officers and camp counselors.
- ☆ In addition, the Association participates in **parades**, an

annual **trail ride**, and other events determined by the members.
