

Waushara County 4-H Horse Association 2007 Membership Rules

- Membership is open to anyone signed up for the 4-H Horse Project, Horseless Horse Project or Exploring Project.
- Annual dues for the association will be \$7 per family.
- The membership year will be from January 1 through October 31 of each calendar year. November and December will be for reorganization and sign up. Membership is closed after the designated deadline. Continuing members are to re-enroll by the November meeting. Enrollment deadline for new members is the January meeting.
- Members attending at least 50% of the association business meetings and participating in one fund raiser (or donating a fixed sum) will be designated as achieving members for that year. Achieving members will receive an end of the year recognition item and be eligible to apply for the conference/clinic scholarship* and reimbursement for their share of the State 4-H Horse Expo sponsorship and tack stall fees.
- Each member must participate in the fund raising activity for the club, or donate a fixed sum per family to the association in lieu of the fund raiser.
- Families will be asked and expected to help with horse association activities.

* A set amount will be budgeted each year for members to apply for a scholarship to reimburse them for part or all of the registration fee of a conference/clinic depending on the number of applications and the budgeted amount. The conference/clinic must be 4-H sponsored, the member must share what they learned at the conference/clinic with the horse association, a scholarship/reimbursement form must be completed and they must be an achieving member to be considered. Leaders can also request scholarships to 4-H sponsored clinics/conferences.
