The Tractor Safety Certification Program is designed to meet state and federal requirements for youth under 16 years old.

You Need to be Certified if You Are...

- **12-13 years old** and operating tractors or self-propelled implements on public roads under direction of your parent or guardian or for work related to your family farm operation.
- **14 and 15 years old** and will be employed (or working without pay) for someone other than your own family farm.

Youth Must Meet ALL of the Following Requirements to be Certified:

- Be at least 12 years old at time of course.
- Attend 24 hours of instructional training.
- Pass a written examination with a minimum score of 70%.
- Pass a practical driving examination which demonstrates tractor driving ability.



Youth attending the Tractor Safety Certification Program will learn about:

Safety:

- Safe tractor and implement operation and farm safety techniques. Youth will learn how to identify potentially hazardous situations and how to reduce the risk of injury in those situations.

Tractors:

- Instruments, controls, maintenance and safety inspections. Youth will learn about the proper use of tractors and learn about tractor limitations.

Operation:

- Youth will be given the opportunity to practice their driving skills and safety understanding. To pass the Certification Program, youth must successfully and safely operate a tractor and 2 wheel implement through an obstacle course.
