

**AIS found and confirmed by DNR:**

The following aquatic invasive species were found during the summer of 2008. Voucher specimens were collected and confirmed by Wisconsin DNR.

Curly-leaf pondweed

Upper White River Flowage a.k.a. West Branch Mill Pond, Waushara County – Found 6/26/08

Alpine Lake, Waushara County – Found 6/25/08

Banded mystery snail

Little Hills Lake, Waushara County – Found 7/25/08

Round Lake, Waushara County – Found 9/3/08

Deer Lake, Waushara County – Found 10/2/08

On October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2008, a visual survey of Eurasian watermilfoil was conducted on Deer Lake. It was reported that the EWM in Deer Lake was spreading. The north end of the lake (especially in the two channels), had an abundance of common bladderwort (*Utricularia vulgaris*). Much of the bladderwort was covered in algae, which made it look extremely similar to the Eurasian watermilfoil that also occupied this area. Common bladderwort is a native plant, beneficial to the lake community. A banded mystery snail found at location 44.04455N 89.21830W (north end) was collected, and confirmed by WDNR.
