### Winnebago Towns-County Planning Committee

September 27, 2001

Mike Koles started the meeting with a continuation of discussion on the Housing Element goals and objectives. Working off the rose colored sheet, discussion took place on the eight objectives listed. Those in attendance then broke into groups of six (two groups) to identify issues and opportunities. These were posted on designated sheets and will be summarized under separate cover.

Warren Utecht of Martenson and Eisele led the group in a review of the Transportation element. Transportation goals, objectives, and policies were reviewed. Maps were displayed with an inventory of existing transportation systems. The primary maps were recreation trails, air transportation, rail transportation, truck transportation, and water transportation. Discussion of future mapping included official mapping.

Issues under transportation included the need to coordinate/interconnect bike paths and recreational trails, providing adequate roads to sustain our economy, and the disconnection of businesses with road changes.

Opportunities under transportation included facts such as, good roads . encourage economic development, tend to give a community a good atmosphere (attractive), quality of life. Limit access by having one road to multiple homes (subdivisions), and having emergency sensitive development.

The entire group was asked to grade policy statements regarding transportation. This was done by reading the displayed statements and placing stickers of green (agree), yellow (moderate agreement), red (disagree) next to the item. The objective was to provide some weight to the proposed statements from our group.
