Minutes of Meeting: Thursday, November 29, 2001
Winneconne Town Hall – 5:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by chairman Ray Batley at 5:05 P.M.

Mike Koles reviewed the previous meeting and talked about the night's agenda. Mike then introduced Mr. Jerry Bougie, Chief Planner for Winnebago County and spoke about his upcoming presentation on the "Utilities & Community Facilities" element of the comprehensive plan. Mike also introduced Mr. Merritt Bussiere, Land Use Education Specialist, University of Wisconsin – Extension, Green Bay. Mr. Bussiere was in attendance to provide the committee with a presentation on the "Natural Resources" element of the comprehensive plan.

Mr. Bussiere then made his presentation followed by a question and answer session. Mr. Bougie then made his presentation again followed by a question and answer session.

The committee then broke into three groups to look for issues and opportunities within each element and identify those using the sticky note process. Each group then gave its report and Mike will compile those into a more comprehensive report for the next meeting.

Mike then called upon Mr. Dave Schmidt of the Winnebago County Planning Department along with Winnebago County Planning and Zoning Committee chairman Mr. John Schaidler to discuss the proposed timetable for moving the "Transportation" element forward for consideration and approval by the County Board. It was agreed by consensus that the meeting of January 10, 2002 would address this element and the issues and opportunities previously identified by the "red, yellow, green" dot method employed by Mike Koles to help identify areas of concern amongst the committee members.

Next meeting dates were established as Thursday, January 10, 2002 and Thursday, January 31, 2002: Both meetings to begin at 5:00 P.M.
