Meeting was opened with a welcome by Ray Batley at 7 PM.
Bert Stitt made the round of introductions noting that there was a good
Mix in those attending.

A report from the management group that meets weekly was given.
One of the questions was how do we get to those who are not
Attending? Thought was given to a date for the next public meeting,
possibly February or early March.

A major handout was given to the group titled: Planning Advisory
Group Meeting No. 6, Winnebago Citizen Planning our Future. Larry
went through the document discussing demographics, age groups,
diversity, and the projected needs of housing for 2020. Town land use
planning changes were discussed along with Decision issues that
accompany town zoning. These decision issues need to square with
the county zoning administration.

There is a need to discuss urbanizing districts and housing which
occurs on the edge of growth areas. Is it affordable and is there sewer
in these areas?

Surrounding all these concerns there needs to be in depth discussion
with a lot of people involved so that intergovernmental cooperation
will be addressed along with implementation and plan adaptation. We
all need to review this document and voice our concerns and
recalibrate some of the issues before us. We will work on Plan
Adaptation Amendments for January '03.
