

**Marinette County Nature Conservation Camp**  
**FY2005/2006**  
**Second Camp – June 2007**

The second Conservation Camp, held June 21-23, 2007. We had nine of the 23 campers attended on full or partial scholarships (three served as dishwashers for their full scholarship), and 17 of the 23 were Marinette County residents and seven of them were 4-H members. Eight girls and 15 boys in grades 6 to 10 participated. I helped to plan the camp, recruited the nurse, the lifeguard and the cook, recruited campers and sent (brochures) and info to 26 other counties for newsletters. I also served as liaison for use of camp as well as equipment and I taught archery and conducted get acquainted and the challenge course. We conducted a follow up meeting and decided to hold another camp next year and attempt to recruit more campers.

The cost of camp had to be increased to \$50 (\$35 last year due to grant), but the remaining \$246 from the Eastern District Resource Management Grant from 2006 was used to cover food costs \$226.80 and towards camp supplies \$22.38.
