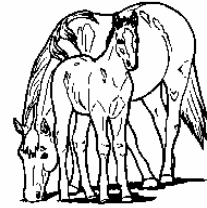


Horse Pasture Management Course



Twenty **online lessons** will be offered from **March 15th through June 1, 2008** by the University of Wisconsin-Extension.

Course participants will need:

1. An internet connection
2. An e-mail account (can be a "free" one from yahoo, hotmail, excite, etc.)
3. A computer with operating system Windows 98 or later MAC OS X or higher
4. A web browser (Netscape 4.7 or higher, Explorer 5.0 or higher)
5. Ability to read CD on computer

Course content includes an assessment of current pasture and horse needs, grazing nutrition, pasture improvement, pasture development, and managed grazing. Emphasis will be on Midwest pastures. This online Horse Pasture Management Course is designed for adult horse owners with one to many horses, but youth horse owners are welcome to participate.
