


What

This three day course will provide an excellent working background for those interested in developing CNMPs.

- Understand the process to become a Certified CNMP Provider
- Understand the overall components of a CNMP
- Know what tools are available to assist in producing a CNMP Plan
- Become familiar with resources needed to develop a CNMP
- Obtain Level II access to USDA electronic information
- See practical applications of the material which will include in-class worksheets, sample CNMP, and tips for success.
- Gain insight into components required by the USDA NRCS for EQIP waste storage cost share.

Course Description



This course includes background and skills for developing CNMPs and working with producers to implement their plans. Guest speakers include specialists from Ohio State University Extension, Michigan State University Extension and the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) in Indiana, Ohio and Michigan. This team of experts is working together to provide participants with well rounded, practical information including all components of a CNMP, including:

- Environmental concerns and regulations for manure management
- Conservation practices for land application of manure
- Selection and implementation of land treatment practices
- Soil, plant and manure nutrient management
- Animal outputs including production, collection, storage, treatment and transfer
- Feed management
- Wastewater handling and storage systems
- Farmstead evaluation
- Record keeping
- Inspection, operations, maintenance and training
- Emergency action planning

Course fee

The \$375 course fee includes instruction, resource materials, snack breaks and lunches for all three days and must be postmarked by **October 23**.
