This is an opportunity to showcase your scholarship in the area of conflict education, highlighting your effective engagement of individuals or groups in the course of your professional life.

The Conflict Education Team is seeking presenters to share practical applications of concepts learned at conflict education workshops. We are looking for both large (BIGs) programming efforts and smaller (BITEs) situations and examples. Programs or cases do not have to be “finished” or brought to resolution, but can be “works in progress” (situations where you are seeking the input of others) or where there are yet steps to take. The Symposia presentations are an opportunity to share real-life/everyday case studies of effective engagement and will be presented via webinar May 14 & 21, 2010, from 10:30 a.m. - noon. Applications are due March 5<sup>th</sup>. It is not necessary to attend both symposia and the planning team will work with applicants to find sites close to their home offices, keeping travel to a minimum.

The goal of the symposia is to:

Highlight scholarly applications of conflict skill sets and conflict theory in UWEX work.

Objectives are to:

- Create a learning forum for analyzing conflicts and applying conflict management skills.
- Promote learning and skills from conflict education workshops and trainings.
