

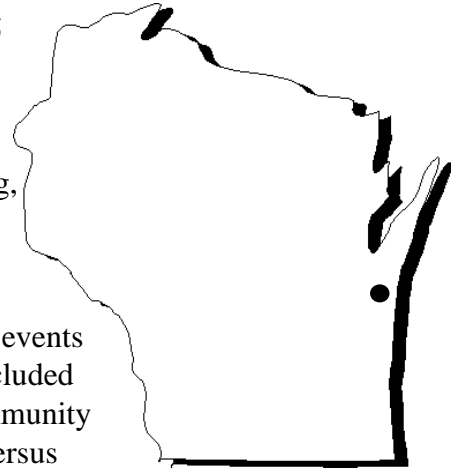
# WI Barn Adaptive Reuse Projects

**Brief Outline of Project:** This barn houses the city's signage shop and is also used for large vehicle and equipment storage and events such as community Clean Sweep Programs. The property that included both the barn and a farmhouse was originally purchased for a community landfill. The city evaluated the cost of building a new structure versus saving the barn and adapting it for their needs. In no way could the cost of adaptation compare to the costs of constructing a new structure with the same amount of space.

**Success of Project:** Because of the height of the structure, the barn serves as an ideal location for storing large equipment such as ladders.
