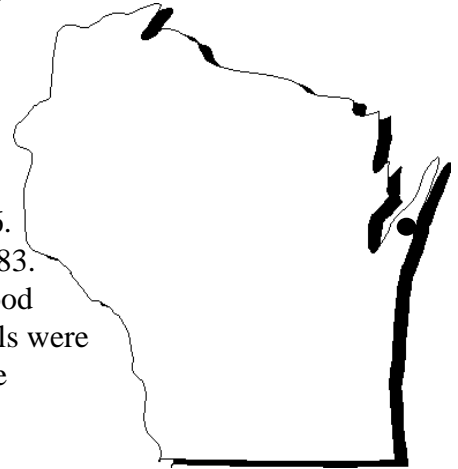

Brief Outline of Project: This dairy barn was formerly part of a 135 acre farm that was farmed for 75-100 years until 1955-56. After sitting vacant, the barn was converted and refurbished in 1983. This included sandblasting the ceilings and saving the original wood beams and most of the wood frame windows. The field stone walls were covered with plaster. The barn is now an integral part of this wine operation.
