The hassle-free way to get paid.


The University of Wisconsin distributes pay using an electronic direct deposit program. Automated Clearing House (ACH) credits employees' pay directly to a financial account.

Direct deposit of pay is convenient, quick, and efficient. It saves you time: your money is directly deposited into your account no matter where you are and even if you can't get to your financial institution on payday.

What makes direct deposit so good?


It's flexible.

You may have your pay deposited in any financial institution throughout the United States and Puerto Rico, whether it is a bank, a credit union, or a financial brokerage firm.



It's convenient.

You don't need to stand in line to get your paycheck or make a trip to the bank to deposit it.

Your money will always be in the account you specify, even if you're on vacation, in class, or ill.



It's free.

There's no charge for this service and your financial institution may even offer incentives such as "free checking" when you participate in direct deposit.

Many campus ATMs offer easy access to your money and most are free.

It's safe.

Unlike a paper check, it will never be lost, stolen, mutilated, destroyed, or forged.

It's fast!

On payday, your money is in your account at the opening of your financial institution's business day. You can withdraw any of your money on the day you are paid.
