

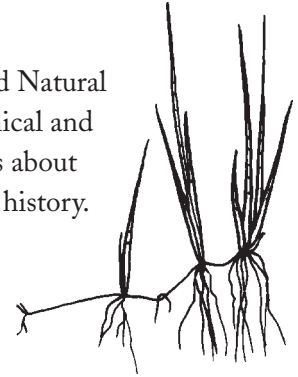
Distribution and habitat descriptions of Wisconsin lake plants

A new book, published by the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey, *Distribution and habitat descriptions of Wisconsin lake plants*, features technical information and detailed drawings for more than 100 species of lake plants that range from the rare to the common.

The publication was designed to provide a basis for the in-depth study of lake plants, but the drawings can also be used to aid plant identification; it should therefore be helpful not only to aquatic ecologists and lake managers, but also to educators, students, and those who enjoy lakes and wetlands.

The 6- by 8½-inch, 266-page book is priced at \$15 per copy, plus applicable sales tax and shipping charges. It has a water-resistant plastic cover and a wire binding, which allows it to easily lie flat when used in the field.

The Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey also sells technical and nontechnical reports and maps about the state's geology and natural history. A free list of publications is available upon request.
